<p>Unit Theme:</p> <p>Thanksgiving!</p>	<p>November 13-17, 2017</p>  <p>Happy Thanksgiving</p>
<p>Language Arts/Reading</p> <p><u>Phonemic Awareness</u> – Students will put syllables and sounds together to make new words. Students will continue to listen for sounds in words. Learn sound for /y/, /k/, and /x/.</p> <p><u>Phonics</u> – Students will practice writing the letters that match the sounds we've learned. Sight words: of, see</p> <p><u>Literature</u> – Students will listen to a story and discuss the characters, setting and plot throughout the week. We will sequence three or more events from a story and retell it to a partner.</p> <p><u>Writing</u> – Students will strongly focus on writing the sounds in the words they want to write, putting spaces between words where needed. Words must match their pictures and they should be able to read them back to the teacher.</p>	<p>Things to work on at home with your child:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Practice writing your name and the sounds you hear in words, putting spaces between words<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Counting to 60 by ones- Read with your child every night and discuss the stories you've read-Practice writing numbers 0-15 every night!-Read the phrases on the back of the newsletter
<p>Math</p> <p>Students will work to compare sets of objects. They will identify groups as having more or less.</p>	<p>TAKE HOME FOLDER</p> <p>Please check your child's folder each night for school information. Any transportation changes should be put in this folder.</p>
<p>Social Studies/Science</p> <p>Students will describe differences in how people live in other places, focusing on suburban and urban areas. We will also discuss foods that are healthy and what food groups they belong in.</p>
