Kindergarten News

Unit Theme:

Winter Weather

Language Arts/Reading

<u>Phonemic Awareness</u> — Students will put sounds together to make new words. Students will continue to listen for sounds in words. <u>Phonics</u> — Students will practice writing the letters that match the sounds learned. Sight words: am, look

<u>Literature</u> — Students will listen to a text and discuss the main topic and details that support the main topic. Students will use a bubble map to organize their thoughts and information they've learned.

<u>Writing</u> — Students will strongly focus on writing the sounds in the words they want to write, putting spaces between words where needed. Capital letters and periods will be used appropriately. Words must match their pictures and they should be able to read them back to the teacher. See websites for rubrics.

Math

Students will work to compare sets of objects. They will identify groups as having more or less.

Social Studies/Science

Students will describe ways the weather changes daily choices. Students will track the weather across the week and discuss any changes or patterns. Students will graph data collected.
