Unit Theme:

Frog Life-Cycles



April 9-13, 2018

Language Arts/Reading

Phonemic Awareness – Students will put multiple sounds together to make new words. Students will break apart the sounds in words with 4 or more sounds.

Phonics – Students will read stories by using picture clues, blending all sounds in words and using sight words learned.

Literature – Students will listen to non-fiction and fiction texts. We will focus on telling the information in a sequential order and on fiction vs non-fiction. We will also discuss WHY the author wrote the books.

Writing – Students will write to tell about the details from the texts. Focus on informational and narrative writings.

Things to work on at home with your child:

- Practice writing sentences about books you read at home
- Counting to 100 by ones and tens
- Read with your child every night and discuss the stories you've read.
- Practice writing numbers 0-20
- Build teen numbers with a group of 10 and more.

Math

Students will continue to focus on making groups of ten and more to create teen numbers. We will also break apart teen numbers to show the parts as 10 and some ones.


